Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	8/2018	Employee crushed middle finger on loader bucket.
2	8/2018	Employee bumped into plastic dumpster causing it to start turning over. Employee reached out to stop other trades tools from falling off of dumpster and hyperextended elbow.
3	8/2018	Employee incurred a sprained knee due to uneven walking surface in parking lot.
4	8/2018	Employee was using a grinder when it made contact with his finger causing a laceration.
5	8/2018	Employee assisting with lowering a transite panel using a manual pulley. Panel caught on scaffold and released while employee was guiding panel with hands and the sharp edge caused a laceration to the left forearm requiring sutures.
6	8/2018	Employee's foot slipped on steps of truck causing a small crack in left foot.
7	8/2018	Employee was stepping out of the back of a pick-up truck, lost his balance and hit the ground hard with left foot causing a fracture.
8	8/2018	Employee stepped into a hole filled with water not realizing how deep the hole was and hurt shoulder trying to keep himself from falling.
9	8/2018	Employee was rolling an 8" piece of pipe to the welder and it ran over his middle finger on his left hand.
10	8/2018	Employee was struck by a wrench falling from above fracturing the bridge of the nose.
11	8/2018	Employee was working with drill when it bound up and hit employee in nose causing a fracture.
