Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	1/2018	Employee lost footing while walking on roof and slipped and fell.
2	1/2018	Employee was lowering pipe when the anchor point failed, and employee was struck in the leg by the pipe causing a fracture.
3	1/2018	Employee fell on berm containment causing a strained lower back.
4	1/2018	Employee slipped on ice on public sidewalk while walking to jobsite causing a sprain/bruise to lumbar.
5	1/2018	Employee was wrecking formwork when a positioning plug fell out the end shore allowing the shore to come down and strike the employee on the lower back causing back strain.
6	1/2018	While hanging drywall employee felt shoulder pop and felt pain causing a hurt rotator cuff.
7	1/2018	Two employees were working in the bathroom of a jobsite cutting a stantion. Employee was making his second cut on the piece while the other employee was rocking it back and forth to break it off. The piece slipped out of the employee's hand and struck the other employee in the head causing a gash requiring 8 staples.
8	1/2018	As employee was getting out of his truck, he placed both feet on the snow-covered ground, stood up and both feet went out from under him.
9	1/2018	Employee was carrying a box of material from the open garage into building four when he slipped on ice and hurt his left knee.
