Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	7/2018	Employee was lowering pipe when the anchor point failed and employee was struck in the leg by the pipe causing a fractured leg.
2	7/2018	An employee brushed his right arm on ceiling grid requiring 5 stitches to close the laceration on right forearm.
3	7/2018	Employee's hand slipped while pulling wire and struck elbow on cabinet causing irritation to bursa.
4	7/2018	Employee strained abdominal while moving light fixtures.
5	7/2018	Employee was working on ladder when he missed rung and fell to ground fracturing heel and tearing a tendon.
6	7/2018	Employee was working next to lull. When equipment was placing material it bounced up and hit the employee in the side causing fractured ribs.
7	7/2018	Employee was working on concrete form wall when he lost balance and fell, hitting wall before lanyard caught him causing a laceration to the head and a possible concussion.
8	7/2018	Employee was climbing down scaffold when he missed step and fell to next level of scaffold fracturing his elbow and wrist.
9	7/2018	Employee lost his footing coming down a lower step of a step ladder, fell, and fractured his pinky finger with contact with the ground.
10	7/2018	Employee cut hand when tightening up whole saw bit when he pressed the trigger on the drill.
11	7/2018	Employee made contact with energized electrical causing primary electrical burns to back and hands.
12	7/2018	Employee was demoing duct work when a piece of sheet metal came down striking him in the forearm causing lacerations affecting nerves and tendons.
13	7/2018	Employee was running a chain fall, the hook came off and swung around hitting him in the mouth cutting his top lip.

14	7/2018	Employee was wrecking plywood from scissor lift and complained that lower back was bother him on the 31st.
15	7/2018	Employee fell through scaffold boards and broke left ankle.
