Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	10/2018	Employee was injured causing a laceration to the head.
2	10/2018	A TM was moving a bottle cart on a truck from the ground and it fell over and lacerated his finger.
3	10/2018	Employee fell while climbing on a Perry scaffold resulting in a fractured rib.
4	10/2018	Employee was using a grinder and the wheel came in contact with his knee causing a laceration require sutures to close the wound.
5	10/2018	An employee was trying to roll a shackle with a sleeve bar, the bar slipped pinching his index finger causing a fracture.
6	10/2018	An employee was driving a company vehicle when the breaks stopped working causing them to hit a tree. The driver dislocated his knee and the passenger fractured a ligament in his right arm.
7	10/2018	An employee dislocated his thumb while prepping tubes by driving a wedge in between 2 tubes.
8	10/2018	An employee was using come-a-long to hold up liner when it came loose. He did not have enough tension on the chain and the liner dropped down and caught his arm between the liner and the chute causing a contusion to his left arm.
