Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	9/2018	Employee was lowering pipe when the anchor point failed and employee was struck in the leg by the pipe, causing it to fracture.
2	9/2018	Employee was rigging material on flatbed trailer when crane lifted material shifted, catching employee's leg between bundles of material resulting in a fractured leg.
3	9/2018	Employee was on a step ladder using a pipe wrench to loosen a pipe union. The union came loose suddenly, and the employee fell catching himself with his right hand, causing a fractured wrist.
4	9/2018	An employee was removing an excavator bucket when the bucket released suddenly causing it to pinch his arm resulting in a bruised wrist.
5	9/2018	Employee was removing a suck truck hose when he pulled it out of the doorway and it fractured his finger by swinging back against the boiler wall.
