Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	5/2020	Employee slipped on a sloped section of roofing while walking from one area of the roof to another causing them to rupture right quadriceps tendon & right patella fracture.
2	5/2020	Employee tore bicep while moving gang box out of walkway.
3	5/2020	Electrician fell from ladder - Separated shoulder and broke three toes
4	5/2020	An employee bent over and tried picking up an object that was too heavy causing a strained back.
5	5/2020	Worker lost control of section of broken concrete while placing it in an excavator bucket. Hand was caught between the concrete and excavator boom causing fingernail to be removed.
6	5/2020	An operator stepped out of an excavator onto uneven ground and rolled his leg causing a fracture.
7	5/2020	Amputation of finger using a table saw - improper use of tool - inexperience worker
