Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	2/2022	(H) Employee's arm was caught in lanyard causing fracture/surgery.
2	2/2022	(H) Employee was using hammer drill causing laceration to right cheek.
3	2/2022	(H) Employee was walking down stairs with a hand cart when they slipped and fell causing a broken bone in foot.
4	2/2022	(I) Employee was pushing a piece of equipment and pulled a muscle.
5	2/2022	(I) Employee was cutting thread overhead with a one handed bandsaw. Bandsaw blade slipped from thread and contacted his left hand on the pointer finger on the first knuckle.
6	2/2022	(I) Employee slipped on some ice and is complaining about the back. (Restricted)
7	2/2022	(I) Employee stepped off of ladder onto a piece of tri-plex cable injuring foot.
8	2/2022	(I) Employee tripped over a bucket around 10 am and landed on his right elbow which jarred his right shoulder. Worked the remainder of the day and it was just starting to get stiff by the end of the day.
9	2/2022	(J) Employee cut hand while placing drinking fountain into box.
10	2/2022	(J) Employee was using a grinder that was not fastened down properly resulting in laceration to left arm.
11	2/2022	(J) Employee was speaking to a volunteer who had a dog on a leash approximately 6-feet away. After employee pointed to a different kennel location to put the dog and lowered right arm, the dog lunged at employee biting right arm.
12	2/2022	(J) Employee was cutting a zip tie, when the blade slipped cutting through his glove on his right hand then cutting in between his thumb and index finger.
13	2/2022	(J) Employee & another worker were lifting a broken toilet out of a dumpster & the broken porcelain part cut through his glove & cut his index finger on his right hand.
14	2/2022	(J) Employee was unstrapping the trailer when he felt a pop on his side rib cage.
15	2/2022	(J) Employee stepped wrong off a ladder causing a knee sprain.
