<b>Incident Number</b>	<b>Date</b>	<b>Incident Narrative</b>
1	3/2022	(H) Employee lifting #10 box of fittings tore bicep muscle. Surgery performed to repair tear.
2	3/2022	(H) Employee's pinky caught between two reels causing a finger fractured.
3	3/2022	(I) Employee got his finger pinched between two pieces of steel resulting in stitches and restrictions as a result of the injury.
4	3/2022	(I) Employee was moving steel plates causing strain/sprain to bicep area.
5	3/2022	(I) Worker was lowering a plate into position when winch tightened up and pinched hand between winch and channel iron causing a fracture to right hand.
6	3/2022	(I) Employee was stepping out of a piece of machinery and stepped into a hole and rolled his right ankle; right ankle is swollen and he cannot put any pressure on it.
7	3/2022	(I) Employee was climbing down from a ladder and hurt his ankle.
8	3/2022	(I) Employee pulled a calf muscle while trying to straighten a ankle bolt.
9	3/2022	(I) Employee was holding some pliers while another employee was using the hammer and missed what he was to hit and hit the employee's Right index finger. Advise that it is split open might need stiches not sure if the bone is broken.
10	3/2022	(J) Employee came in contact with shelving sharp edge that resulted in sutures.
11	3/2022	(J) Employee was pushing up a dump hopper to dump resulted in laceration to the forehead.
12	3/2022	(J) Cut arm on sharp piece of metal resulting in stiches.
13	3/2022	(J) A crew was completing a furnace install at a residential home. The furnace room was extremely tight with very little room to perform the install. Lifting from the bottom of the furnace the two-man crew went to place the furnace on the coil. At first, they thought the unit was set but then noticed they needed to move it slightly to be flush with the coil. As they made the final adjustment one of the crew members had his right index finger caught in between the furnace and the coil. Naturally, he pulled his hand out as quick as possible which ultimately caused a laceration requiring stitches.
14	3/2022	(J) During the process of moving equipment to a new location a crew member was cutting zip ties that were used to secure an item to their gang box. He was using a razor blade knife to cut through the zip tie. He was able to cut the first zip tie without any issue. When attempting to cut the second zip tie the knife blade was facing upward towards him. As soon as the zip tie was cut through, the end of the razor blade made contact with his wrist leaving a puncture wound that required treatment beyond first aid.
15	3/2022	(J) Employee was carrying a roll of Geo-grid over his right shoulder and when setting it down on the ground, the roll snagged on his hoop earring, causing it to tear from his earlobe laceration to right earlobe.
16	3/2022	(J) A strap hook came loose causing a laceration to upper lip.
17	3/2022	(J) Aluminum wire struck employee in mouth chipping front teeth.
18	3/2022	(J) Employee stepped in unprotected floor opening causing pain to right arm resulting in surgery to repair bicep.
19	3/2022	(J) Foot got caught in mat causing pain to ankle. Diagnosed with fractured ankle.
20	3/2022	(J) Finger pinched between tailgate and transformer causing laceration. Stitches were applied to wound.

21	3/2022	(J) Employee was squatting down to install some boxes into a wall and felt a pop in right knee when he twisted it. Stretched it out and seems to be okay so worked the rest of the day.
22	3/2022	(J) Employee was moving a fitting from a stand to the weld table when the stand tipped over and landed on his left foot.
23	3/2022	(J) Individual slipped on ice on job site resulting in a twisted ankle and cracked fibula.
24	3/2022	(J) Employee was pulling a section of pipe from the laydown yard and felt a pop in their shoulder resulting in injury.
