Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	4/2023	(H) Employee slipped while cutting with torch. He grabbed the rail to prevent falling. This motion put his arm and shoulder in very awkward position causing dislocation.
2	4/2023	(H) Crew was shutting down the project when 40 mph gusts arose and caused a piece of plywood to strike a worker in the face resulting in a facial laceration and a fracture to his maxillary sinus.
3	4/2023	(H) Employee slipped climbing down from equipment injuring groin, surgery required.
4	4/2023	(I) Employee smashed his finger between torque head and bolt. Surgery performed to place pin.
5	4/2023	(I) Employee was stepping over a steel beam when he tripped and landed on his shoulder resulting in a torn muscle.
6	4/2023	(I) Employee was using a razor blade to cut open the top of a 5 gallon bucket of solution when the razor blade slipped and cut his other arm.
7	4/2023	(I) Employee was weld testing and reached to steady the grinder and cut his finger.
8	4/2023	(I) Employee was putting pipe down and overextended his elbow.
9	4/2023	(J) Drywallers screwed a sharp metal track onto their scissor lift to raise drywall. The employee cut his arm on the metal track while walking by the drywall lift. Sutures were required.
10	4/2023	(J) Employee was removing bolts, ratchet slipped and struck in mouth fracturing tooth. Resulting in tooth replacement/crown.
11	4/2023	(J) Employee working on equipment, tripped and fell striking head, laceration, sutures.
12	4/2023	(J) Employee stepped off equipment, stepped on ground fracturing lower leg. Employee returned to work no surgery required.
13	4/2023	(J) Employee was working on a rack and it sliced his wrist between his glove and sleeve.
14	4/2023	(J) Employee was standing in the corral waiting for a bundle of pipe when a metal shaving fell/blew into his eye.
15	4/2023	(J) Employee was cutting a strap on a bundle of pipe, went to catch the bundle and his hand got caught between the bundle and the forklift.
16	4/2023	(J) Employee descending extension ladder, ladder started to shift, employee jumped from ladder, landed on feet resulting in a broken left heal.
17	4/2023	(J) Carpenter failed to tie off while working at height on a wall pour. He lost his balance & fell, resulting in a broken leg.
