Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative	
1	1/2023	(H) Slipped in elevator shaft while tied off causing a contusion to the knee.	
2	1/2023	(H) Cleaning snow out of pickup causing lower back pain.	
3	1/2023	(H) Cleaning chute of material and accidently closed chute door on arm resulting in hospitalized and off work.	
4	1/2023	(H) Worker was working in an JLG (MEWP) with tracks. The worker drove up the JLB up an incline, once the units center of gravity peaked the change in elevation, the unit moved downward quickly. The movement resulted in an catapulting action for the operator in the basket. He slammed his chin into the railing of the basket causing a broken jaw.	
5	1/2023	(I) Employee was driving a forklift heading towards interior of building. While going over a small gap, forks became unhinged. While trying to fix the forks himself, one of the forks slipped and landed onto employee's foot.	
6	1/2023	(I) Employee was in a boom lift, while driving forward, he hit a rut & the bucket lifted up a bit & he hit his head on the bar joist. Employee stated that he felt nauseous & threw up.	
7	1/2023	(I) Employee was moving 6-inch pipe and the pipe got caught in table and that is when he felt the muscle strain in right shoulder and neck.	
8	1/2023	(I) Employee had a 4-inch pike on the lift and was in the process of moving it and he got his left-hand pinky finger smashed.	
9	1/2023	(I) The employee was handling fire suppressant pipe, in elevated aerial lift placing pipe into the hanger, began feeling wrist and hand pain.	
10	1/2023	(J) While adding a tooth to a sheet metal brake the workers finger was on the underside of the tooth. At the time he was adding the tooth, the lever on the left side of the machine was not locked in place. With the lever not locked in place the clamping bar engaged pinching his finger underneath the tooth. He then pulled his finger out. The pinch and pull and the corner of the tooth created the laceration requiring stitches.	
11	1/2023	(J) Tightening conduit resulted in pop occurring in right thumb.	
12	1/2023	(J) During demo of HVAC equipment employee described pop in shoulder MRI scheduled.	
13	1/2023	(J) While employee was drilling overhead concrete anchors, had on safety glasses, did not wear a face shield. Later after work employee said he felt like something was in his eye.	
14	1/2023	(J) Filing cabinet tipped over onto retail employee causing undetermined back sprain .	
15	1/2023	(J) Unbolting coupling for a gear box, over exertion when attempting to loosen bolts causing back strain.
