Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative	
1	3/2023	(H) Stepped on a board with a nail that punctured his foot.	
2	3/2023	(H) Strained lower back while carrying objects off a truck.	
3	3/2023	(H) Flash occurred causing burn to arm. Hospitalized and surgery required.	
4	3/2023	(I) Employee was installing a hanging heater. As a result, strained left shoulder tearing rotator cuff in the process.	
5	3/2023	(I) Employee was removing tap con screws to remove guardrails from the façade of a Parking Garage working out of a scissor lift. The scissor lift basket was cantilevered beyond the guardrail barrier to access work. It was discovered that the free-wheeling valve knob was disengaged causing the scissor lift to drift west back into the PG building and pinning the employee between the scissor lift and the precast beam. Resulting in bruising/contusion to the chest.	
6	3/2023	(I) Employee helping unload doors and hardware from delivery semi and while loading pallet jack in the back of a semi, the pallet jack dropped on employee's left hand and cut/smashed his pinky finger.	
7	3/2023	(I) Employee was taking a cap off a piece of 8in pipe, air pressure behind cap, blew off and struck employee in the head.	
8	3/2023	(I) Employee was cutting a piece of pipe with a reciprocating saw - it jumped off the pipe & cut his left hand. Cut required stitches.	
9	3/2023	(I) As employee was finishing a fire inspection, he went back to the backflow to fill system back up. As employee was coming down, stepped on uneven pavement on sidewalk, rolled ankle over and heard loud pop on his left ankle.	
10	3/2023	(I) Employee was grooving pipe when his thumb got smashed in between wheel and pipe.	
11	3/2023	(J) Electrician was moving a battery with a dolly. The battery slid off of the dolly while moving. The worker tried to catch the battery and it was pinched in between another object. This caused a laceration.	
12	3/2023	(J) Piece of construction material entered his eye causing irritation.	
13	3/2023	(J) Cut to face when a rod slipped and struck employee.	
14	3/2023	(J) As employee was cutting pipe with band saw, bandsaw jumped off pipe & cut employee's finger resulting in 8 sutures.	
15	3/2023	(J) Employee fell from material trailer. He put his hand out to catch himself, causing a fracture.	
16	3/2023	(J) Employee was using a portable band saw and got it caught up in the back of cut level 3 glove. Inch and a half laceration to the back of left hand on his index finger knuckle.	
17	3/2023	(J) Employees were lowering pipe into the basement level. The load of pipe was swaying slightly, and the employees finger got caught in between the load of pipe and the concrete wall which caused a laceration.
