Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	7/2023	(H) Employee tripped and twisted an ankle.
2	7/2023	(H) Employee was ejected and pinned between his extended scissor and another scissor when it was hit by another subs forklift.
3	7/2023	(I) Employee was coming off a ladder and stepped on material that was laid out and rolled his ankle.
4	7/2023	(I) Employee was coming down off a ladder when the ladder shifted causing him to roll his ankle.
5	7/2023	(I) Pipe slipped and landed on employee's foot.
6	7/2023	(J) Employee was installing drains piping in the ceiling resulting in laceration to wrist.
7	7/2023	(J) Employee was knelling down wiring a motor and leaning back on his heels. While doing so, he felt a twinge in his knee. Employee tore tendon in knee.
8	7/2023	(J) Employee cut thumb with a knife resulting in stitches.
9	7/2023	(J) Punctured finger with nail sticking out of concrete wall.
10	7/2023	(J) While moving piece of steel, employee cut wrist.
11	7/2023	(J) Employee was hooking strap in hoist when they caught their finger between strap & load resulting in a laceration.
12	7/2023	(J) Employee operating portable band saw with one hand. Cut left index finger requiring sutures.
13	7/2023	(J) Light load in scissor lift fell over and pinched the employee's fingers between the platform and the light resulting in laceration.
14	7/2023	(J) Employee was bending to pick up a two-piece road sign out of the trailer and felt pain in his low back. This resulted in lumbar strain.
15	7/2023	(J) Employee was sorting through round steel stock and as he was placing a piece back onto the rack, he pinched his left ring finger causing pain resulting in a laceration.
16	7/2023	(J) Employee was turning a panel over on a sawhorse. The panel began to slip when the sawhorse started to tip. As he tried to catch the panel it struck his right arm resulting in laceration.
17	7/2023	(J) Employee was in the process of ascending a ladder to inspect roof for leaks when they were attacked by multiple wasps. Employee was stung nine times by wasp and had history of allergic reaction.
18	7/2023	(J) Employee pinched finger in scissor lift resulting in a fracture.
19	7/2023	(J) Employee was hit in the knees by a wire cart.
20	7/2023	(J) Employee got debris in his eye while using a grinder with wire wheel (he was wearing safety glasses & face shield).
21	7/2023	(J) Employee was cutting the metal band off a pipe bundle and the band snapped and cut her arm.
22	7/2023	(J) Employee was carrying a form to the edge of a bank of footer when employee's knee was injured. Sprained ACL.
23	7/2023	(J) Finger laceration which required stitches.
