Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	9/2023	(H) Employee fell to a different level resulting in a fractured leg and wrist.
2	9/2023	(I) Employee was installing pipe, when the opposite end rolled which caused the end he was installing to jump and caught his finger between the pipes.
3	9/2023	(I) Employee tripped & fell over a curb in a parking lot.
4	9/2023	(I) Employee was lifting a piece of pipe to another employee when it slipped and smashed his finger between 2 pipes.
5	9/2023	(I) Employee was reaching for a box on the floor and tripped and fell to the ground.
6	9/2023	(I) Employee was walking down a hill and stepped on a rock & twisted his knee.
7	9/2023	(I) Employee was stocking pipe and received a laceration to his hand.
8	9/2023	(I) Employee was loosening a vic on a butterfly valve when it popped off and hit him.
9	9/2023	(J) Employee was driving in a nail and hit finger with hammer resulting in broken index finger.
10	9/2023	(J) Employee was cutting conduit with a bandsaw. Was holding the conduit with one hand while cutting it with a bandsaw in the other hand. Slipped with the bandsaw and cut his thumb on the left hand.
11	9/2023	(J) Employee picked up one side of the pipe with 3 rolls of wire by himself so he could lay it on the ground. The 3 rolls of wire slid as he was putting it on the ground and the pipe landed on the employee's finger resulting in a cut.
12	9/2023	(J) Laceration to hand due to not wearing gloves.
13	9/2023	(J) Laceration to forearm.
14	9/2023	(J) Employee was operating chainsaw with proper PPE and when task completed, she took off face shield, wiped her face, and felt debris in left eye.
15	9/2023	(J) Employee was operating telehandler and as he moved to side of the road for traffic, slid into ditch and equipment tipped over resulting in a right shoulder strain.
16	9/2023	(J) Employee strained his back gathering material (Setting bundle of light track on drywall cart) for his task.
17	9/2023	(J) Employee cutting chain and had saw kickback resulting in laceration to finger.
18	9/2023	(J) While using a polishing wheel, employees beard caught in the wheel and cut him.
19	9/2023	(J) While installing hangers, employee cut his arm on sharp edge of bar joists.
20	9/2023	(J) Employee was exposed to some nitro acid pickling paste fumes causing a cough.
21	9/2023	(J) Employee was walking down flight of stairs and his knee popped.
22	9/2023	(J) Employee was opening a piece of equipment to clean a strainer. Once open to atmosphere, hot water sprayed out hitting him in abdomen and arm resulting in 1 st and 2 nd degree burns.
23	9/2023	(J) Electrician was given restricted days for a muscle strain and prescription. When moving material he strained his back.
