1	10/2023	(H) Employee's foot slipped off last step of scissor lift resulting in a torn ACL.
2	10/2023	(H) Employee was walking down a flight of stairs where they twisted knee at customer site.
3	10/2023	(H) Employee was using a rolling scaffold and was standing on top of it. He was attempting to move it while standing on top of it and fell as a result. Employee fractured left wrist and left hip.
4 10/2023 (H) Fell to a di		(H) Fell to a different level off of extension ladder during descent resulting in compression fracture of T2 vertebrae, bruised right hip, and left knee sprain.
5	10/2023	(H) Employee was walking to storage when they slipped on ice and fractured their skull.
6	10/2023	(H) Employee fell from 8 ft. ladder resulting in broken shoulder and ribs.
7	10/2023	(I) One of our transfer drivers was delivering a load of scrap metal. After he was emptied he pulled up to close his trailer door. The excavator that unloaded him hit the trailer door and then the door swung hitting the employee resulting in bruising of back and shoulder area.
8	10/2023	(I) Employee was cutting a bracket with a band saw & cut his finger.
9	10/2023	(I) Employee was jumping to retrieve a laser that was on a wall and felt a pop in his knee when he landed.
10	10/2023	(I) Employee got his hand caught between the dumpster & pipe being thrown away and cut his hand.
11	10/2023	(I) Employee fell off a flatbed while trying to free a piece of material and received cuts/bruises on his arm.
12	10/2023	(I) Employee was moving a piece of pipe over another when the piece on the bottom slipped out from underneath and crushed his thumb in between them.
13	10/2023	(I) Employee was trying to straighten a pipe at a joint and felt a pop in his shoulder.
14	10/2023	(I) Employee was walking and stepped into a hole, he tried to catch himself and landed on his shoulder.
15	10/2023	(J) Employee received a closed fracture of left wrist as a result of a fall.
16	10/2023	(J) Employee had debris in eye.
17	10/2023	(J) Employee stepped on rock while stepping off scissor lift twisted hip and leg and knee strain.
18	10/2023	(J) Employee cut hand on nail that was sticking out of edge of a concrete slab resulting in a laceration to palm of hand.
19	10/2023	(J) Employee was handling material using the buddy system and partially tore bicep.
20	10/2023	(J) Employee was taking apart a scissor lift so it could be moved. One of the panels fell on the employees left hand resulting in left thumb fracture.
21	10/2023	(J) Employee was installing ground rods with a hammer and struck his right index finger causing a laceration.
22	10/2023	(J) During wire pull operations, the wind shaft sprung up after employee pulled the pin, striking his mouth and cracking his tooth.
23	10/2023	(J) Employee was cleaning material trailer while wearing proper PPE. When he lifted a broken standoff glass insulator, it made contact with his left wrist causing laceration.

24	10/2023	(J) Employee used improper tool for the job and poor body positioning which caused carpenter to make contact with saw on their finger resulting in laceration.	
25	10/2023	(J) Employee injured knee while stepping off a ladder.	
26	10/2023	(J) Employee was on a rack, mishandled a coupling which fell to the ground level and hit another employee resulting in a chipped tooth.	
27	10/2023	(J) Employee was tearing apart a drain valve when the wrench he was using slipped and hit him in the mouth cutting his upper lip.
