1	12/2023	(H) Employee's leg was struck by scissor lift.	
2	12/2023	(H) Employee ran over foot with lift.	
3	12/2023	(I) Employee caught finger in a door to an air handler which resulted in a laceration	
4	12/2023	(J) Employee was wiping a dry erase board and scraped his pinky finger on the aluminum outside edge of the dry erase board, resulting in a laceration that needed stitches.	
5	12/2023	(J) Employee was attempting to lift some spiral duct and it struck his forearm which was not covered resulting in a laceration to his arm.	
6	12/2023	(J) Employee received laceration requiring sutures on index finger from bandsaw.	
7	12/2023	(J) Employee was using a bandsaw to cut the tip of a C-clamp. While holding the clamp in his left hand he used the bandsaw with his right hand. As the blade made its way through the clamp it struck his left index finger leaving a laceration that required stitches.	
8	12/2023	(J) Employee strained of right knee.	
9	12/2023	(J) Employee was exiting bucket truck cab when he fell causing discomfort to left knee.	
10	12/2023	(J) Employee was wearing safety glasses while working underneath truck and debris fell into his right eye causing discomfort.	
11	12/2023	(J) Employee cut his thumb using a band saw.	
12	12/2023	(J) Laceration to face.	
13	12/2023	(J) Worker was moving a fan housing with 4 other workers, they pushed the fan housing, it moved quicker than expected contacting the boot of the worker.	
14	12/2023	(J) Employee experienced carbon monoxide poisoning.
