Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	2/2024	(H) A 10' long boring rod fell out of place for the 6' wide hydraulic arm to pick up. Employee put hand on rod in the 6" hydraulic arm area and told the operator to active the hydraulic arm to pick the rod up. The hydraulic arm came out and pinched the employees' hand between itself and the edge of the boring machine frame. Resulted in broken hand with multiple fractures.
2	2/2024	(H) Employee was cutting threaded rod with bandsaw when glove caught and pulled finger into blade resulting in a laceration.
3	2/2024	(H) Employee cut himself with a knife trying to cut a zip tie off of a bundle resulting in a laceration.
4	2/2024	(H) Employee amputated finger when using a core drill.
5	2/2024	(I) Severe right ankle sprain as the employee rolled their ankle stepping off of a stair onto a concrete pad.
6	2/2024	(I) Rupture of right bicep while lifting ductwork into scissor lift.
7	2/2024	(J) Employee carrying 2"x10" plywood with 2"X4" framing footer form that weighs approximately 60 pounds to the next excavation 40' away slipped and fell and the footer form landed on his hand resulting in a hand contusion.
8	2/2024	(J) Employee was lifting end of trench box whaler that needed to be pushed forward on a bed of a truck. As it was pushed from the other end, his hand was pinched between the whaler and the trench box shield that were loaded in front of it. Employee fractured pinky finger.
9	2/2024	(J) Piece of concrete fell on employee's foot resulting in a fractured toe.
10	2/2024	(J) Shelving rack fell over on employee while he was operating a lift resulting in four broken ribs.
11	2/2024	(J) Employee moving material; caught back of left hand on rough metal; cut through glove.
12	2/2024	(J) Employee was pulling wire under grating and felt debris in his right eye causing discomfort.
13	2/2024	(J) Employee was zip tying cables to back of solar panels, slipped and fell on ice causing pain to right lower back area.
14	2/2024	(J) Employee was operating a grinder while wearing face shield and when he removed face shield, a piece of debris went into his left eye causing discomfort.
15	2/2024	(J) Placed foot under a component of a fork lift fracturing toe.
16	2/2024	(J) Employee & forklift operator were transferring pipe from fork to cart when a pipe got stuck. A nearby employee went to assist and when the pipe released, it rolled over the employees hand.
17	2/2024	(J) Employee lacerated forearm requiring stitches.
18	2/2024	(J) A team member was getting out of their vehicle to start their shift and slipped on ice, resulting in a back injury.
19	2/2024	(J) A laborer was using a sledgehammer to demo tile/plaster from a wall and as he struck the wall, an overhead pipe fell, striking his arm and required stitches.
