1	1/2024	(H) Employee was standing in connex container and as he stepped forward to receive material, he slipped and fell, twisting his left knee causing pain.	
2	1/2024	(I) A team member was descending the steps of his articulating dump truck and his hand slipped from the handrail. He regripped the handrail and felt a pop in his elbow. The team member suffered a torn triceps tendon	
3	1/2024	(I) Employee pivoted on left leg in paved parking lot resulting in meniscus tear.	
4	1/2024	(I) Employee slipped & fell as he was walking toward the break trailer.	
5	1/2024	(I) Employee lacerated their finger.	
6	1/2024	(I) Employee lacerated their finger.	
7	1/2024	(J) Employee walking on path slipped on ice strained lower back	
8	1/2024	(J) Employee walking on path slipped on ice fell on lunchbox fractured rib	
9	1/2024	(J) Employee was drilling hole when drill motor hung up, twisting right wrist, resulting in closed fracture.	
10	1/2024	(J) Employee cut leg trying to remove a zip tie	
11	1/2024	(J) Employee was using a dull knife to cut rope towards body, after cutting through rope the knife stabbed the employee in lower leg.	
12	1/2024	(J) Employee was using power pony to thread pipe on trust and pony caught causing pain in his right elbow.	
13	1/2024	(J) Employee was walking down exterior stairs, slipped and fell causing pain to left ankle/leg.	
14	1/2024	(J) While employee was removing his harness, the lanyard hit him in the mouth and chipped a tooth.	
15	1/2024	(J) Employee was climbing a ladder when he slipped and caught his hand on a rung of the ladder resulting in a laceration.
