Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	3/2024	(H) Employee tripped on an electrical cord and fell on the floor, damaging his knee.
2	3/2024	(H) Employee was operating a core drill when it encountered a piece of reinforcement. The drill torque causing the employee to fall back injuring their shoulder.
3	3/2024	(H) Employee tripped on a snow blanket while uncovering a concrete slab pour and tripped and fell on ankle resulting in a fracture and dislocation.
4	3/2024	(J) Laceration to the middle finger requiring four stitches.
5	3/2024	(J) Employee's left hand caught between pipe and skid causing fracture.
6	3/2024	(J) Employee was clearing debris from mag drill when bit got caught up causing laceration to right index finger.
7	3/2024	(J) Team member placed his hand in a pinch point and suffered minor laceration.
8	3/2024	(J) Employee cut arm throwing trash away.
9	3/2024	(J) Employee building a scaffold and was installing a metal scaffold pan overhead. Pulling into position pulled too hard and pan came off the support bar and struck him in left calf.
10	3/2024	(J) Employee tipped over a lull while he was moving skids. Employee received 3 stitches and 3 staples along with 3 broken ribs.
11	3/2024	(J) While changing out an inline grease duct fan, a portion of the duct fell striking the employee in the head leaving a laceration that required staples.
12	3/2024	(J) Employee sustained a soft tissue injury to the left shoulder, torn labrum from pulling wire.
13	3/2024	(J) Employee was exiting pulp truck while stabilizers were coming down and struck his head causing a laceration.
14	3/2024	(J) Employee was in the process of canting a pole straight. As he was pushing on cant hook, it broke and he fell forward, striking his right ring finger on the railing of garlock causing laceration.
15	3/2024	(J) Crew was unloading the pole and placing it on the cribbing with forklift. The employee was in the process of removing the shackle when the left fork shifted and hit employee on the top of his hard hat causing pain in his lower neck area.
16	3/2024	(J) Employee was cleaning up jobsite while wearing gloves. He picked up a cutout, it broke and cut through his glove causing a laceration to his right ring finger.
17	3/2024	(J) Employee was grooving a piece of pipe and his finger got pinched between the pipe and the rubber wheel that keeps the pipe straight.
18	3/2024	(J) Employee struck the edge of a 3/4" plywood, smashing his finger between the bar and the wood. This caused an avulsion to the pad of his left hand index finger.
19	3/2024	(J) Employee cut thumb with utility knife.
20	3/2024	(J) Slipped on ice when getting out of car and fell on their bottom.
