| 3 | 8/2024 | (H) Employee attempted to realign a pipe while it was in a groover machine and his finger got caught in the pipe causing the tip of his finger to be sliced off. | | |
| 4 | 8/2024 | (H) A carpenter was sawing a 2X10 and in his attempt to keep the scrap from falling into creek, he reached down with his free hand to grab it. Lacerations to fingers of right hand. | | |
| 5 | 8/2024 | (I) Employee was putting a vacuum on a liquid line and ammonia got on the employee's arms. | | |
