Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	9/2024	(H) Employee fell from same level and fell awkwardly on his elbow resulting in a torn tendon.
2	9/2024	(H) Employee's right hand middle finger-tip was crushed when ascending mast crane in service man basket. They were holding onto the attachment point to the mast when the basket reached the stop bar attached to mast.
3	9/2024	(H) Dual crane tipped over with man basket attached to boom and employee fell 60 feet and dislocated and fractured their ankle.
4	9/2024	(H) Dual crane tipped over with man basket attached to boom and employee fell 60 feet resulting in a micro vertebrae fracture.
5	9/2024	(H) Employee improperly used step ladder accessing the top of a client's walk-in freezer, resulting in a reinjured back when they caught themself.
6	9/2024	(H) Employee fell from height resulting in fractured bones.
7	9/2024	(H) Employee fell from height resulting in fractured bones.
8	9/2024	(I) Team member tripped and fell. They landed on their shoulder and suffered a sprained AC joint.
9	9/2024	(I) Employee was dismantling a switch mat, removed a bolt from the support brace, and it struck the top of his left foot causing pain.
10	9/2024	(I) Employee was drilling a hole in an IMP wall when the hole saw caught & twisted the drill in his hand.
11	9/2024	(I) Employee as core drilling some holes and the drill spun and smashed his hand between the drill and a bar joist.
12	9/2024	(I) Knee Sprain while walking from one area of the project to another.
13	9/2024	(I) Employee turned his ankle while carrying baker scaffold down a flight of stairs, resulting in a sprained ankle.
14	9/2024	(J) While removing valve, the hand was caught between valve and wall, resulting in a fracture of the right hand.
15	9/2024	(J) Employee was changing the battery in a company truck while not wearing gloves, resulting in a laceration on their left hand.
16	9/2024	(J) Employee fractured ring finger metacarpal when drill bit hung up while drilling hole in SS sheeting.
17	9/2024	(J) Employee tripped over tool bag causing fall and fractured patella.
18	9/2024	(J) Employee smashed their finger in pinch point requiring stitches. The finger was smashed between a utility pole and process pipe while attempting to move it.
19	9/2024	(J) Employee was tightening a strap with a winch bar and when he released pressure, the bar struck his neck causing laceration and cracking a tooth.
20	9/2024	(J) Employee was operating a handheld bandsaw while wearing gloves when the blade bound up in the cut. As he was freeing the saw, his right index finger made contact causing laceration.
21	9/2024	(J) Employee was sliding a pile of roof drains to one side of a pallet when they slid off the pallet and landed on his foot.
