Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	10/2024	(H) Employee was unhooking a 30T spreader beam and unhooked it from the crane without having proper cribbing under it. The beam rolled over on his foot causing a hairline fracture.
2	10/2024	(H) Employee was pulling ropes through a backyard, lost his footing, and tripped causing pain to his left ankle.
3	10/2024	(I) Employee cut his finger with a carbon steel black pipe while installing sections of an air handling unit, resulting in stitches.
4	10/2024	(I) Employee strained his rib while digging.
5	10/2024	(I) Employee was standing on hoses to pull measurements. The hose pulled off the fitting causing the employee to lose his balance and fall but landed on his feet causing a pain in his lower back.
6	10/2024	(I) Employee was cutting a band off a pipe bundle that snapped back and cut his arm.
7	10/2024	(J) Employee sprained their ankle due to uneven concrete at a contractor site.
8	10/2024	(J) While using a grinder to grind a weld, the grinder kicked back, causing a laceration to the employee's nose.
9	10/2024	(J) Employee smashed their finger while bending a conduit.
10	10/2024	(J) Employee rolled their ankle, causing a fracture, by tripping on a pallet while carrying a bag of mortar.
11	10/2024	(J) Employee was using a chain hoist and it snapped and hit him in the mouth, causing injury to teeth.
12	10/2024	(J) Employee was moving equipment and got his hand caught between the equipment and beam, resulting in eight stitches needed in his hand.
13	10/2024	(J) Employee got their fingertip pinched in a pan and sheet metal brake, resulting in partial amputation to the finger.
14	10/2024	(J) Employee had an allergic reaction on the jobsite, resulting in the use of Naproxen and Epipen.
15	10/2024	(J) Employee was removing a press head from a wire, and something flew into their eye, causing a slight injury to their right eye.
16	10/2024	(J) Employee was bitten by fire ants while working and had an allergic reaction from the bites.
17	10/2024	(J) Employee was using a wrench to turn turnbuckle; it slipped off and struck him in his mouth, chipping his teeth.
18	10/2024	(J) Worker did not have ladder fully in locked in position, fell backwards, and broke their wrist when trying to catch themselves.
19	10/2024	(J) Employee received a laceration to their arm from bumping into a unistrut above the ceiling.
20	10/2024	(J) Employee was stripping wire to pull conduit and cut his finger.
21	10/2024	(J) Employee was using a utility knife to remove a zip tie and cut his thumb.
22	10/2024	(J) Employee was moving a fan behind a Bama saw when his thumb slipped into the fan and was cut.
23	10/2024	(J) Employee overextended their left knee resulted in sprain, strain and swelling.
24	10/2024	(J) Trade Partner Employee under Turner contract made contact with welding rod that penetrated their arm.
25	1/2024	(J) Dog bit employee, resulting in stitches.
