Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative		
1	11/2024	(H) Employee was climbing a wall panel to break a tie while wrecking. When the employee was climbing from the 2^{nd} rung to the 3^{rd} rung to tie off, he slipped and pushed himself off of the panel. Employee landed flat on his feet, resulting in an ankle fracture.		
2	11/2024	(I) Employee was cutting metal bands off a bundle of pipe and the band popped and cut his wrist.		
3	11/2024	(I) Employee was pushing out deck extension and had pain in the knee.		
4	11/2024	(I) Employee was working on a lift close to some bundled mc cables and smashed his fingers between the cables and the guard rail of the lift.		
5	11/2024	(J) Employee was handling sheet metal without wearing the proper cut resistant gloves, resulting in a laceration to employee's left index finger.		
6	11/2024	(J) Employee was cutting a pipe with a grinder. The pipe was to be cut below grade and abandoned in place. The portion of the pipe above ground was being held in place by a forklift so cutting and removal could take place. The employee making the cut was positioned at the end of the forks to make the final cut. As the pipe was cut the pipe shifted and fell off the forks landing on the employee's right knee. Employee sustained a laceration on his right knee.		
7	11/2024	(J) A ladder collapsed, resulting in a fracture to the employee's leg.		
8	11/2024	(J) Employee tripped and landed on his shoulder, resulting in a fractured shoulder.		
9	11/2024	(J) Employee was holding a piece of wood to assist in installing a vibratory caisson. During this process, the piece of wood shifted, and his gloved left index finger was pinched resulting in a laceration.		
10	11/2024	(J) Employee smashed their pinky and wedding finger while moving a transfer motor, resulting in stitches.		
11	11/2024	(J) Employee was cutting a piece of pipe with an oversized band saw with only one hand on the tool. When the cut was completed, the employee lost control of the tool and struck his forearm with the blade still engaged, resulting in a laceration requiring 5 stitches.		
12	11/2024	(J) Employee was using a bucket to collect condensate from a line but mistakenly put the bucket over the steam line and steam burned his shoulder.		
13	11/2024	(J) Employee was walking past another employee installing flex brackets in a ceiling from a scissor lift. As the employee was walking past, a flex bracket fell out of the ceiling grid and hit the employee's ear.		
14	11/2024	(J) Employee cut his left index finger while using a bandsaw to cut conduit, resulting in sutures.		
15	11/2024	(J) An employee was removing an existing sprinkler system from a building using a bandsaw. Employee was cutting a pipe with a bandsaw and the saw slipped off a pipe resulting in a laceration on our employee's finger.
