Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	1/2025	(H) Employee was descending stairs on boom truck when his boot got caught, causing him to fall. He made contact with the door of a nearby Conex box and fell to the ground causing a laceration on his head.
2	1/2025	(J) Employee was welding a flange onto the end of a 6-inch pipe. His partner went to roll the pipe on the v pipe stands while the other end fell off (employees had burlap sacks rolled up and placed between the pipe & pipe stand to keep from scratching new paint), causing the pipe to teetertotter and hit the employee in the chin.
3	1/2025	(J) Employee received a cut on his left index finger from a bandsaw when it was being passed from another person to him, and he dropped it on his left hand.
4	1/2025	(J) Employee was using a tool and his hand slipped off the tool. Employee's arm hit a piece of sharp metal, resulting in a laceration to their right arm.
5	1/2025	(J) Employee was cleaning the back of a pickup truck with bed cover. Their left hand slipped, causing their hand to impact the metal cover support, cutting the base of their thumb.
6	1/2025	(J) Employee was installing a bundle spacer when he felt discomfort in his left chest muscle, resulting in a strain.
7	1/2025	(J) Employee was moving large steel plates with another employee when his left index finger was pinched by the steel plate causing a laceration.
8	1/2025	(J) A warehouse employee slipped on ice after a snowstorm, causing a leg and ankle injury.
9	1/2025	(J) Employee was walking and stepped/slipped on some guardrails that were covered by snow and fell landing on his side causing a cut and severe pain.
10	1/2025	(J) Employee was driving a digger derrick truck too close to the shoulder of the roadway and his tire went off the roadway onto the soft shoulder, causing the vehicle to overturn, injuring the employee's wrist.
11	1/2025	(J) Employee suffered laceration to left thumb which needed 8 stitches. The employee got their thumb caught in the arms of a door closure while wiping down the top of a door slab. When the door closed slightly, the employee's thumb was caught between the closure arms causing the laceration.
