Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	2/2025	(H) Employee slipped by stepping onto a stool, which moved, falling off a truck, resulting in a sprained arm.
2	2/2025	(I) While forming a cast-in place staircase, employee stumbled on double mat rebar, resulting in a hairline fracture to the right fibula.
3	2/2025	(J) Employee slipped on ice, resulting in an injured knee.
4	2/2025	(J) Employee was exposed to gas due to a plant upset, resulting in respiratory irritation.
5	2/2025	(J) Employee was struck in mouth by handle of post hold digger, resulting in a laceration to the upper lip.
6	2/2025	(J) Employee suffered minor injury from hydro nozzle penetrating their right forearm.
7	2/2025	(J) A piece of metal fell on an employee's leg while moving it.
8	2/2025	(J) Employee received a cut on their finger when a piece of metal flew toward him due to high winds.
9	2/2025	(J) Employee was cutting tape off a bundle of cables, and as he cut in an upward motion while holding the bundle, he made contact with his left wrist, resulting in a laceration.
10	2/2025	(J) Employee had booties on and as he stepped onto a metal brace, his foot slipped and hit the floor, resulting in a bruised arm and lower back.
