## **CCS Programs and Benefits**

- ◆ **CCS Certification Program**
  - Easy to identify safer contractors
  - Less time spent reviewing contractors
  - Helps ensure contractors on your site meet safety requirements
  - Can be used as a complete contractor safety pre-qualification program or as an accepted form of contractor safety pre-qualification
- ◆ **CCS Substance Abuse Program**
  - Model substance abuse program to put requirement in place that all contract workers must present a valid CCS card and be available to work before entering jobs
  - Identify workers who have passed a drug and alcohol screen in the past year
  - Helps ensure you have a drug free workplace
- ◆ **Worker Training Database**
  - Verify individual worker's safety training
  - Check prior to coming on site or performing a task
  - Helps ensure workers have required safety training
- ◆ **CCS Safesite**
  - Portal to check CCS Cards for individual workers
  - View availability of workers based on substance abuse program testing
  - View individual worker training
  - Add employees to your account
  - Generate reports
  - Direct Contact to Third Party Administrators and CCS Staff
