Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative		
1	5/2025	(H) Employee was riding a UTV with their leg outside of the UTV. They hit a dumpster while trying to throw away trash, resulting in a fractured leg.		
2	5/2025	(H) Employee made electrical contact, resulting in electrical burns to the left hand and right forearm from an arc flash.		
3	5/2025	(H) Employee received an arc flash burn from improperly using a phase rotation meter, resulting in burns to his forehead and hands. He weas not wearing his proper PPE.		
4	5/2025	(I) Employee slipped when getting out of equipment and sprained their knee.		
5	5/2025	(J) Employee was removing a stuck bandsaw without having resistant gloves on, resulting in a lacerated finger needing three stitches.		
6	5/2025	(J) Employee suffered a corneal abrasion resulting from a ceiling wire scratching their right eye.		
7	5/2025	(J) Employee pinched their finger between 70-pound steel pipe supports, resulting in a fracture and stitches to their pinky fingertip.		
8	5/2025	(J) Employee fell 3 feet from a step ladder, fracturing their right arm.		
9	5/2025	(J) Employee was cutting roll of material on the ground with a demo saw when saw blade contacted their leg, resulting in a laceration.		
10	5/2025	(J) Employee was pulling a pin that holds a breaker and pinched his thumb between the breaker and the machine when the breaker swung on the remaining pin.		
11	5/2025	(J) Employee strained their back while handling cabling.		
12	5/2025	(J) Employee pinched their finger while installing a conveyer lid.		
13	5/2025	(J) A load break probe broke off in a bushing, causing the equipment to fail, resulting in an ARC flash. The employee received first degree burns to their face and neck.
