Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	7/2025	(H) Employee working in a bucket above injured employee, dropped a temporary "Hot Arm" 50', striking the injured employee in the back resulting in fractures to ribs (right #7 & #8) and neuro thorax (right).
2	7/2025	(H) Employee borrowed a grinding stone from another welder that he had never used before. Grinding stone shattered off of angle grinder resulting in laceration above employee's left eye, fractured nose, eye socket, and forehead.
3	7/2025	(I) Skid collapsed causing heavy stone to drop approx. 2" on top of employee's left foot causing bruising and swelling of foot.
4	7/2025	(I) Team member stepped down from a piece of equipment and rolled his ankle.
5	7/2025	(I) Employee overexerted themselves while pulling pipe wrench resulting in a hernia.
6	7/2025	(I) Employee dropped bucket on foot and fractured left great toe.
7	7/2025	(J) Employee reports he was sucking up water and mud through a 4" hose. He was standing in the mud. The hose got plugged with mud and debris. The hose whipped and pushed him backwards and he was knocked around straining his lower back.
8	7/2025	(J) Employee states that he was driving, sitting at a stop light when his vehicle was rear ended (NRVA). He injured his right shoulder, right elbow, neck, upper right back, right calf, left hip, and left kneecap.
9	7/2025	(J) Employee's drill caught and spun resulting in a sprained wrist.
10	7/2025	(J) Employee received a laceration to pinky from 2x4 falling during repositioning of wall panel.
11	7/2025	(J) Employee fractured finger when it was caught between two material carts.
12	7/2025	(J) Employee was cutting a 10' stick of ¾" conduit that was resting on a scissor lift. When the cut was complete he tried to catch the remaining stick. This resulted in him putting his left wrist in the point of operation on the bandsaw and he cut his left wrist.
13	7/2025	(J) Employee was unhooking dirt bad from winch line, employee pushed hook, it came back striking them resulting in a laceration to the left eyebrow.
14	7/2025	(J) Employee's right ring finger was smashed between manhole cover and the opening resulting in Tuft Fracture/Laceration to the right ring finger.
15	7/2025	(J) Employee was setting duct which resulted in a laceration to the finger.
