Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	9/2025	(H) Employee slipped on steps and strained his back.
2	9/2025	(H) Employee twisted his knee while walking down stairs, resulting in a torn ligament.
3	9/2025	(H) While removing pipe above the ceiling grid, employee lost balance and fell approximately 10 feet to the ground, resulting in a punctured lung and broken ribs.
4	9/2025	(I) While installing barricade tape, one of the outriggers from a carry deck crane came down and landed on employee's foot.
5	9/2025	(I) Improperly stored jack hammer fell onto employee foot and dislocated metatarsals.
6	9/2025	(I) Employee tripped while climbing into an air handler and landed on his knee and shoulder and sustained a laceration to the knee.
7	9/2025	(I) Employee slipped on dew-covered pipe in the laydown yard, resulting in a hairline ankle fracture.
8	9/2025	(I) While crossing a structural I-beam from a scaffold, the employee lost balance when the fall protection retractable locked, causing a knee hyperextension.
9	9/2025	(I) Employee lost balance when the fall protection retractable locked while crossing a structural I-beam from a scaffold and fell backward, dislocating their shoulder.
10	9/2025	(I) While repositioning a battery grinder in an aerial lift, employee accidentally activated it, causing a laceration to the left arm when it caught on their welding jacket.
11	9/2025	(J) Employee cut his finger with a utility knife while opening a box of materials.
12	9/2025	(J) Employee's arm came into contact with sharp metal on a rebar road basket and sustained laceration.
13	9/2025	(J) While lifting right arm to vacuum a hole, employee sprained ligaments of the spine.
14	9/2025	(J) Employee fell and broke his elbow while lifting a concrete parking block.
15	9/2025	(J) A Piece of debris was blindly thrown towards dumpster, which struck an employee above his right eye and lacerated his forehead.
16	9/2025	(J) While cutting pipe, employee attempted to catch it as it began to fall, resulting in the bandsaw striking and lacerating their arm.
17	9/2025	(J) While using wire strippers to strip cable, the employee sustained a laceration to the thumb when the blade slipped and cut through their glove.
18	9/2025	(J) Employee's arm slid against metal pipe banding and sustained laceration while cutting it off a bundle of pipe.
19	9/2025	(J) Debris landed in employee's eye while grinding pipe.
20	9/2025	(J) Employee got debris in eye while switching from welding hood to hard hat.
21	9/2025	(J) A medical needlestick stuck an employee through a trash bag during removal.
22	9/2025	(J) A clamp fell above employee working on exterior framing, bruising his hand and weakening grip strength.
23	9/2025	(J) An employee sustained laceration to head after tripping over a large boulder while manually guiding new pole into hole.
24	9/2025	(J) Drill got caught and spun in employee's hand, causing soreness & stiffness in fingers.
