Incident Number	Date	Incident Narrative
1	11/2025	(H) Employee was adjusting the setting chain on a pole, when his glove got caught in the chain and pinched the tip of his left thumb between the chain and pole, resulting in laceration and fracture.
2	11/2025	(I) Employee fractured a thumb from carrying supplies down stairs and tripping on a piece of scaffolding sticking out.
3	11/2025	(I) While exiting a scissor lift, the employee's left knee struck the sharp edge of a stud, causing a laceration that required stitches.
4	11/2025	(I) Employee dislocated his kneecap while squatting down to pick up a tool.
5	11/2025	(I) While cutting underground pipe for demolition, the saw bound in the cut and kicked back, striking the employee's chin.
6	11/2025	(I) Employee sustained an impact fracture to the knee while placing a bollard in a hole.
7	11/2025	(J) While moving an oil filter, employee tripped causing laceration to forearm.
8	11/2025	(J) Employee was not wearing gloves while handling wood and sustained a large splinter in the palm of the hand requiring sutures.
9	11/2025	(J) While pressure washing moving conveyor belt, employees hand was struck requiring sutures.
10	11/2025	(J) While lifting material overhead, employee felt pain in shoulder.
11	11/2025	(J) While tightening bolts on a scaffold, the wrench slipped and struck the employee's head, causing a laceration.
12	11/2025	(J) Handle of grinder was not attached and the grinder kicked back while cutting a weld, causing lacerations to the employee's index finger and thumb.
13	11/2025	(J) While loading concrete slabs into a dumpster, one employee lost grip on a slab, pinching the second employee's fingers between the slab and the dumpster, resulting in a fracture of the ring finger.
14	11/2025	(J) A bee was in the filter box that the employee was changing, and employee was stung on the palm.
15	11/2025	(J) While installing drywall overhead, a piece became dislodged and struck the employee on the foot, fracturing the metatarsal bone.
16	11/2025	(J) Employee pulled out excess material while installing HVAC overhead, causing debris to enter the employee's eye and leading to infection requiring prescribed medication.
