1	10/2025	(H) While driving, tire came off of another vehicle and rolled in from of employee's vehicle, causing accident and injuries to the employee's face, neck, back, and bilateral arms.		
2	10/2025	(H) An energized wire broke and fell on employee below, causing electrocution and burns to right hand and both knees.		
3	10/2025	(H) Employee was stripping a cable with a utility knife and cut their left wrist.		
4	10/2025	(I) Employee reinjured a tendon while pulling concrete forms.		
5	10/2025	(I) Employee tweaked his back and had a sharp pain while breathing as a result of pulling concrete forms.		
6	10/2025	(I) An employee's hand got pinched between pipe and a job box while material was being lifted with a lull, resulting in a contusion.		
7	10/2025	(I) A bandsaw slipped down the pipe while an employee was cutting a piece of pipe, resulting in a laceration to the hand.		
8	10/2025	(I) While trying to remove a nail sticking out from a crate, the nail cut through the employee's gloves and lacerated his hand.		
9	10/2025	(I) Employee sustained a left knee strain while using a ladder.		
10	10/2025	(J) While using a portable bandsaw, employee sustained laceration to the left-hand index finger knuckles.		
11	10/2025	(J) Employee cut the back of the hand past the glove while installing HVAC duct work.		
12	10/2025	(J) A portable grinder kicked back while employee was cutting through a weld, causing laceration to the hand.		
13	10/2025	(J) Employee sustained a laceration to the finger when removing outer jacket of a cable with a knife.		
14	10/2025	(J) When pulling equipment, employee slipped and bruised tailbone.		
15	10/2025	(J) While pulling fiber optics cable, employee struck an I-beam and received laceration above the eye.		
16	10/2025	(J) Employee was struck on the mouth while disassembling two vac hoses, fracturing a tooth.		
17	10/2025	(J) Employee sustained a tendon tear while pulling cable and reported discomfort in the left bicep area.		
18	10/2025	(J) Employee left excavator bucket off the ground resulting in an employee hitting his forehead on the stationary bucket and receiving laceration to the forehead.		
19	10/2025	(J) Employee lost control of a prybar causing it to hit the face causing a laceration and a loose tooth.		
20	10/2025	(J) Scaffold-grade plank fell from a higher level and struck employee in the arm, causing contusion.		
21	10/2025	(J) Employe's finger was smashed between poles while loading/securing utility poles on a trailer, causing a laceration to the index finger.		
22	10/2025	(J) Employee was removing insulation from ground wire with a knife, resulting in a laceration to the left palm.		
23	10/2025	(J) Employee lost control while opening folding knife and gave himself a laceration to the palm.		
24	10/2025	(J) While removing conduit, employee struck the back of his right hand causing a laceration requiring 6 sutures.
